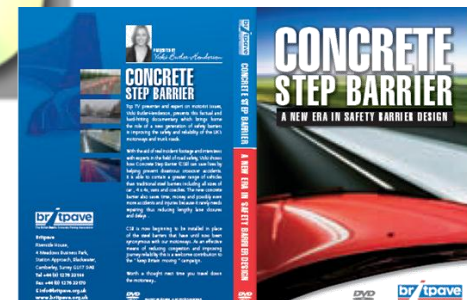
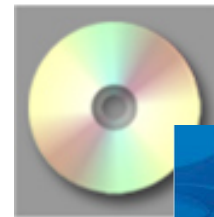
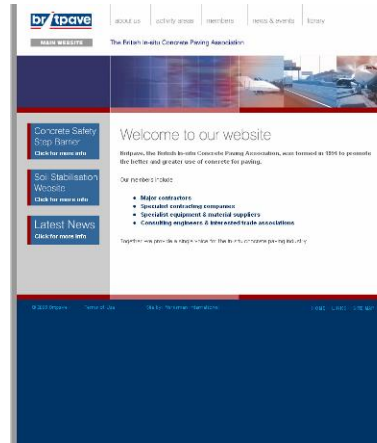
Objectives

Soil Stabilisation Task Group

- Issues: Technique often regarded as a “black art”
